

DEPARTMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

Local and State Rules govern this competition in addition to local 4-H rules and AHSA rules.

- 1. **ELIGIBILITY** Open to all California 4-H and FFA members (in good standing), and independent Junior and Adult Competitors from California.
 - a. Competitors must be ages 9 & older by January 1, 2024.
 - i. **Exception:** Junior Exhibitors participating in *Open Lead Line* may be as young as 5 years old by January 1, 2024.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 2. ENTRY FEES \$5.00 per Exhibitor. \$5 per Class.
 - Fees are NON-refundable.
 - b. One (1) Fair Admission ticket + Parking is included.
- 3. **REQUIRED FORMS & ADDITIONAL FEES** Due in order to participate. All forms can be emailed to fairexhibits@marincounty.org and check payment should be mailed to the Marin County Fair Fair Office (Attn: Horse Show) at 10 Avenue of the Flags, San Rafael, CA 94903.
 - a. Insurance Fee \$15.00 per Exhibitor.
 - i. Fees are NON-refundable.
 - ii. 4-H & Pony Club Members covered by their own insurance must complete a Horse Show Waiver of Liability Form.
 - iii. Independent Junior and Adult Exhibitors shall provide insurance coverage as required by the Fair.
 - b. Code of Ethics Required for all Exhibitors regardless of age or competition division/class.
 - c. Medical Release Required for all Exhibitors regardless of age or competition division/class.

COMPETITION RULES

- 4. Horse Show Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes after the entry deadline.
- 5. **SECTIONS** NO cross-entering between sections:
 - a. Ages 9-11
 - b. Ages 12-13
 - c. Ages 14-18
 - d. Pony

- e. Walk/Trot (Jog)
- f. Riders with Special Needs
- g. Adult (19 & Older)
- 6. HORSE SHARING Horses may be shared between Exhibitors.
 - a. A shared Horse may be ridden in more than one section.
 - b. The Exhibitor/Rider may not enter more than one section.
 - c. Riders may not cross-over lead line and off line.
- 7. Stallions are NOT permitted to be shown.
- 8. SPECIFIC CLASS RULES For specific Division Rules, please refer to Division(s) in the following pages.
 - a. *Pony Classes* are open to any Horse or Pony that is 14.2H or less (based on the height of the animal, not the age of the Exhibitor).
 - b. Walk/Trot Classes are open to beginner riders.
 - c. Walk/Trot Class Exhibitors/Riders may NOT cross-enter into NON-Walk/Trot Classes.
 - d. "First-year Riders" is defined as Exhibitors who have NOT competed in the Horse Show previously.
- 9. **JUDGING** The American System of Judging applies.

a. The judge's decision is final.

10. HEALTH & SAFETY -

- a. When mounted, a properly fitted ASTM-SEI Equestrian Helmet must be worn at all times.
- b. All Junior Exhibitors must be supervised at all times by an adult.
- c. There will not be an on-site veterinarian present.

11. APPAREL REGULATIONS -

- a. English Apparel for English Riding Classes to include shirt, breeches, knee boots or jodhpurs with jodhpur boots, ASTM-SEI equestrian helmet, English type coat, tie, or choker suitable for English attire, belt (crop and unrowled spurs optional).
- b. Dressage Apparel for Dressage Riding Classes should mirror that of English (see Rule 10a).

PUBLICITY

12. The Marin County Fair reserves the right to photograph any entries for educational, catalog, website, or publicity purposes.

LIABILITY

13. The County of Marin, Marin County Fair, and/or its contractors will not be responsible for loss or damage which may occur from any cause.

DIVISION 501 | DRESSAGE

Entry Fee: \$5.00 per class

Exhibitor must follow Dressage guidelines listed below:

- > Show will be run according to USDF guidelines.
- > No more than three tests per horse.
- > Be prepared to move up if there are cancellations.
- > All tests will be ridden in Short Court.
- > Dressage times (approximate) will be posted at the arena the morning of the competition.
