 - a. All Entries must be the original content and current work of the writer and created within the last two years.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 2. ENTRY FEES \$5.00 per Entry
 - a. Fees are NON-refundable.
- 3. ENTRY LIMIT 2 Entries PER Exhibitor PER Class
 - a. The same entry may not be entered in more than one class or division.
- 4. **IDENTIFICATION** Only the <u>TITLE</u> may appear on the front of the Entry. Exhibitor Name, Division/Class# should be listed on the back of the entry.
- 5. ENTRY REMOVAL Accepted works shall not be removed from exhibition until the Fair closes.
- 6. **ENTRY RELEASE** Entries must be picked up on release day. Entries will only be released by presenting your claim check, personal identification, or a signed letter of authorization from the exhibitor.

COMPETITION RULES

- 7. Entries must either be neatly mounted with a MAXIMUM SIZE of 9" x 11.5" or submitted in a folder.
 - a. Folders may or may not be included in the displays.
