

DEPARTMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **ELIGIBILITY** - Open to all California youth competitors (both 4-H and non-4-H) ages 5 - 18.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 2. ENTRY FEES \$2 per Entry.
 - a. Fees are NON-refundable.
- 3. **ENTRY LIMIT -** 2 Posters per Exhibitor.
 - a. The same entry may NOT be entered in more than one class or division.
- 4. **ENTRY TOPIC**—Entries may be on any topic related to agriculture, environmental conservation, animals, etc. See Division 640 for Poultry Education Snapshots.
- 5. **ENTRY SIZING -** 2'x3' for Poster Entries (maximum) | Tri-Fold Science Fair Display for Tri-Fold Entries.
 - a. Please note that you may enter your Presentation Day poster or tri-fold display.
- 6. **CREDENTIALING** Each exhibitor will receive one admission credential and one fair combined admission/parking credential. Limit of one parking credential per family.

COMPETITION RULES

7. Entries will be judged on educational value, design, and neatness.

8. The Marin County Fair reserves the right to photograph any exhibitor/animal/entry in the exhibition for educational, catalog, website, or publicity purposes.
