

DEPARTMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

Local and State Rules govern this competition.

1. **ELIGIBILITY** - Open to Marin, Sonoma, and Napa County youth competitors (both 4-H and non-4-H) ages 5 - 18. Youth from outside counties may compete if coop space is available.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 2. ENTRY FEES \$5.00 per Bird | \$5.00 per Dozen Eggs | Free for Showmanship & Poultry Judging
 - a. Fees are NON-refundable.
 - b. Fees INCLUDE: Food, water, & care of animal(s).
- 3. **ENTRY LIMIT -** 2 Entries PER Exhibitor, PER Class
- 4. ENTRY IDENTIFICATION All Birds must be identified by Leg Bands (and listed on Entry Form).
 - a. Leg band numbers must match the exhibitor's entry form.
 - i. Leg Bands will be provided during Coop-in if needed.
- 5. **POULTRY ARRIVAL AND INSPECTION**: All birds must be inspected before being allowed on the fairgrounds. An Inspection station will be set up outside the entry gate on the Avenue of Flags. Exhibitors must stop and have all their birds inspected between 7:00 am 9:00 am. Confirmation of passing inspection will be given to the exhibitor to present at Coop-In.
- 6. **REQUIRED MEETING** A mandatory meeting for Exhibitors and their parents will be held on Monday, July 2, at 10:00am in the Fur & Feathers Tent. All purchased wristbands will be distributed at this meeting.

CREDENTIALING FEES & RULES

- 7. **CREDENTIALING FEES** \$15.00 per Exhibitor (Wristbands are for Exhibitors ONLY)
 - a. \$20.00 fee for Wristband replacement if lost.

- b. Wristband fees are NON-refundable.
- c. Each Exhibitor should purchase a Barnyard Wristband which covers admission for the 5 days of the Fair.
- d. Please note that Exhibitors participating in one-day shows ONLY, will not be eligible for wristbands.

8. CREDENTIALING RULES

- a. Failure to load in an animal will result in a forfeit of wristband.
- b. All Parents, Guardians, and/or Volunteers will receive one fair admission credential and one combined fair admission/parking credential based on the number of days on-site.
- c. Exhibitors, Parents, Guardians, or Volunteers who have been found giving away their Wristbands or Credentials will be sanctioned with revoked privileges and cash prizes withheld.

ANIMAL ROOM & BOARD

- 9. Display Cages will be provided by the Fair.
 - a. All Exhibitors are expected to perform Cage Cleaning before Birds are released on Sunday, July 6, beginning at 5:00pm.
- 10. Food AND Water dishes should be provided by the exhibitor.
- 11. Birds will be fed by Fair Staff.
 - a. For Exhibitor wishing to feed their own birds, feeding must be done BEFORE the fair opens.
- 12. During coop-out, Animals must be claimed and picked-up by the Competitor. Any other individual must have a signed letter of authorization from the Competitor.
- 13. The Poultry area has fans and air coolers.

COMPETITION RULES

- 14. Definition and judging procedures as prescribed in the *American Standard of Perfections* (copyrighted by the American Poultry Association Inc.). Procedures shall apply to all District and County Fair poultry shows, provided that they do not conflict with any rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food & Agriculture's Fairs & Expositions Division.
- 15. Competitors must have owned their Birds at least 30 days PRIOR to the Competitive Exhibits Entry DEADLINE.
 - a. All Birds must be AT LEAST four months old.
- 16. A Judge or Fair Management may remove any Bird from competition if it appears to be fatigued or out of condition.
- 17. All Egg entries become property of the Fair.

PUBLICITY

18. The Marin County Fair reserves the right to photograph any exhibitor/animal/entry in the exhibition for educational, catalog, website, or publicity purposes.

LIABILITY

19. The County of Marin, Marin County Fair, and/or its contractors will not be responsible for loss or damage OR illness or death of a pet which may occur from any cause.

- > ENTRY LIMIT 5 Prints per exhibitor
 - The same image may NOT be entered in more than one class or division.
- > Prints may be framed or unframed.
 - Unframed Prints must be mounted on mount-board or foam core which cannot be larger than the Print or the board size of 16" x 20".
 - Prints may be matted. Any color mat board is acceptable.
- > Film processing and printing may be done commercially.
- ➤ Individual print only. No photo series. (Exception: a series or collage may be entered in Class 9 if framed as one item, 16" x 20" maximum).
- > Photos may be taken with any device (camera, mobile phone, field glasses, GoPro, drone camera, etc.)
