

DEPARTMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

Local and State Rules govern this competition.

1. **ELIGIBILITY** - Open to all California residents. Entries must have been grown by the Exhibitor within the county, district and/or community that the Exhibitor represents.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 2. ENTRY FEES \$2.00 per Entry | Free for Produce Art
 - a. Fees are NON-refundable.
- 3. ENTRY LIMIT 1 Entry PER Class.
- 4. **ENTRY REMOVAL** Accepted plants shall not be removed from exhibition until the Fair closes.
 - a. Entries not collected on Release Day will be discarded.
- 5. **ENTRY RELEASE** Entries must be picked up on release day. Entries will only be released by presenting your claim check, personal identification, or a signed letter of authorization from the exhibitor.

ENTRY RULES

See Division for specific rules.

- 6. All Entry containers are to be labeled on the bottom with the Exhibitor's name, division, and class information.
 - a. Do NOT use irreplaceable containers.

PLANT CARE

- 7. Upon receipt, Floriculture & Horticulture will be under the exclusive charge of the Department Coordinators. Coordinators will give daily care (watering).
 - If you do not want your plant watered during the Fair, please notify a Coordinator at time of delivery to opt-out.

PUBLICITY

8. The Marin County Fair reserves the right to photograph any work in the exhibition for educational, catalog, website, or publicity purposes.

LIABILITY

9. The County of Marin, Marin County Fair, and/or its contractors will not be responsible for loss or damage which may occur from any cause. Any entries received damaged will not be juried.

SCORING RULES

- 10. Agricultural & Horticultural entry quality must, at least, equal the quality of the commercial market and/or maturity (ripeness) as required by the State Food & Agricultural Code in order to be considered for Premium Awards. See 2025 State Rules for California Fairs for more information.
 - a. **MATURE** | Defined as having reached the stage of ripeness to ensure palatability after removal from tree, plant or vine.
 - b. **OVERRIPE** | Defined as having any advanced state of maturity undesirable for human consumption.

11. "Monstrosities" will not be considered for Premium Awards unless entered in *Division 259 | Giant or Unusual Vegetables & Fruits*.

DIVISION 250 | GARDEN HARVEST

Entry Fee - \$2.00 per entry

Entries must follow the guidelines listed below:

- ➤ Any combination of 5 or more different varieties of fruits, nuts &/or vegetables grown in your garden.
- > You may enter 1 or more of a certain species or variety (Example: 1 watermelon, 4 squash, 12 beans).
- > Attractively arrange your harvest in a basket, open box, or container of your choice.
